

YEAR 7 LANGUAGE CHOICE

Dear Parents

Next year your son/daughter must select a Modern Foreign Language option as part of his/her Year 7 curriculum. The languages offered within the timetable are French and German Foreign Language.

Students who are already proficient in one of these languages are strongly advised to learn a new foreign language, as both French and German are offered at beginners' level only.

Your son/daughter will have a taster lesson to help him/her decide during this year's online transition days.

Parents and pupils should take into account that the language students opt for now will be studied for the next three years at Key Stage 3. At the end of Year 9, pupils may opt to study the language further to IGCSE examination level and then on further to IB/A-level.

Please note that students with a proficient level in French or German could be considered for direct entry into IGCSE in Year 10 or 11 after discussion with the Head of Modern Foreign Languages and the Head of Key Stage 4.
